are words that remind us of the meaning of Christmas.



REPAYMENT OF EQUITY

Every year NVCU undertakes an equity pay out to all members that have attained the age of 75. last year, NVCU's Board of Directors lowered this age to 70 and this year to 65. If you are one of these individuals your entire equity balance will be paid to you with the exception of \$ 5.00 which will be retained in your name to ensure that your membership continues into the future.
